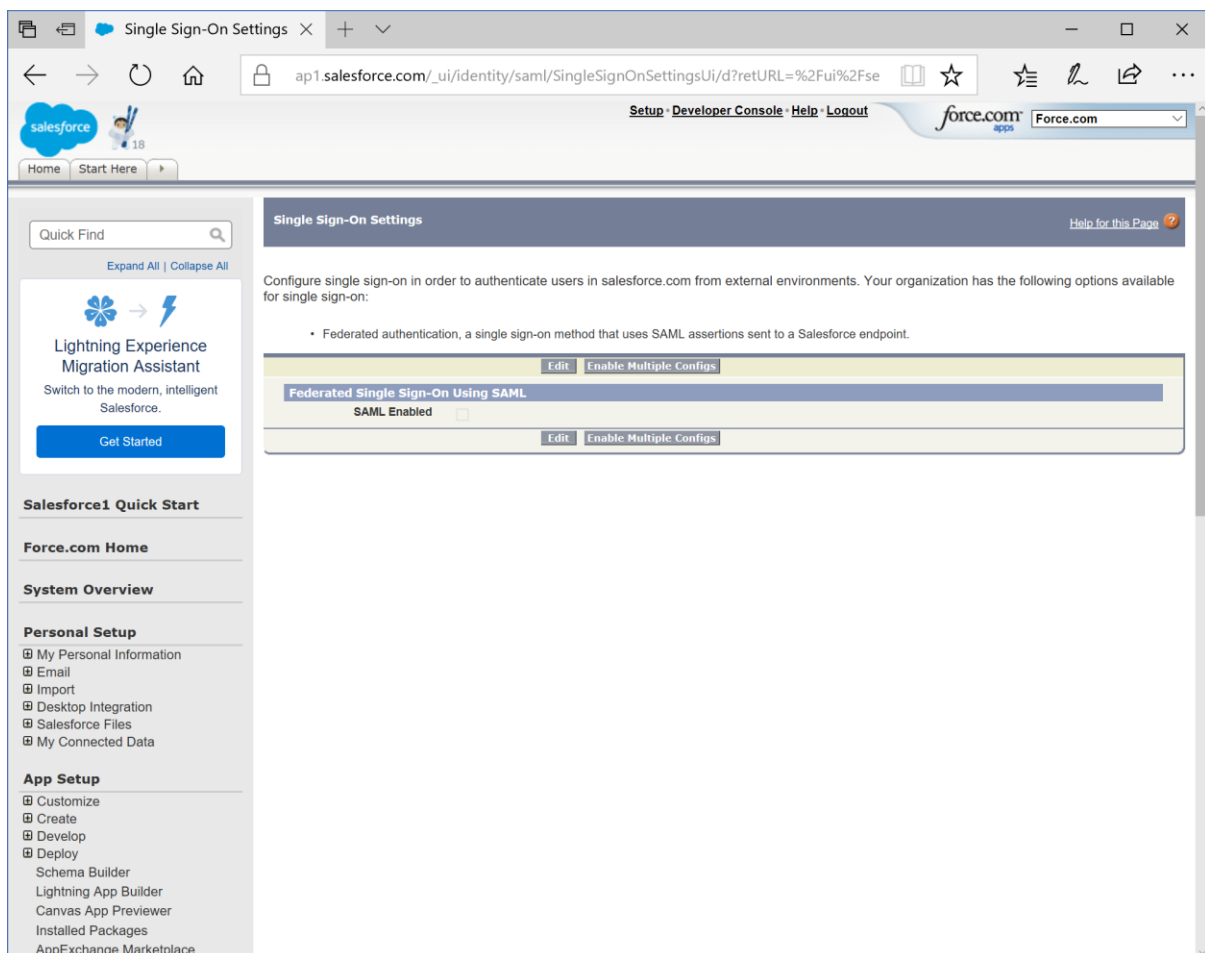

Single Sign-On Settings

Log into Salesforce as an administrator.

<https://login.salesforce.com>

Select Setup > Administration Setup > Security Controls > Single Sign-On Settings.



Enable SAML and specify the identity provider's configuration.

The issuer is the name of the identity provider.

For example:

<https://ExampleIdentityProvider>

The identity provider Login URL is the SSO service that receives the SAML authn request as part of SP-initiated SSO.

For example:

<https://localhost:44313/SAML/SingleSignOnService>

The certificate is the identity provider certificate used to verify signatures.

For example:

idp.cer

Single Sign-On Settings

Configure single sign-on in order to authenticate users in salesforce.com from external environments. Your organization has the following options available for single sign-on:

- Federated authentication, a single sign-on method that uses SAML assertions sent to a Salesforce endpoint.

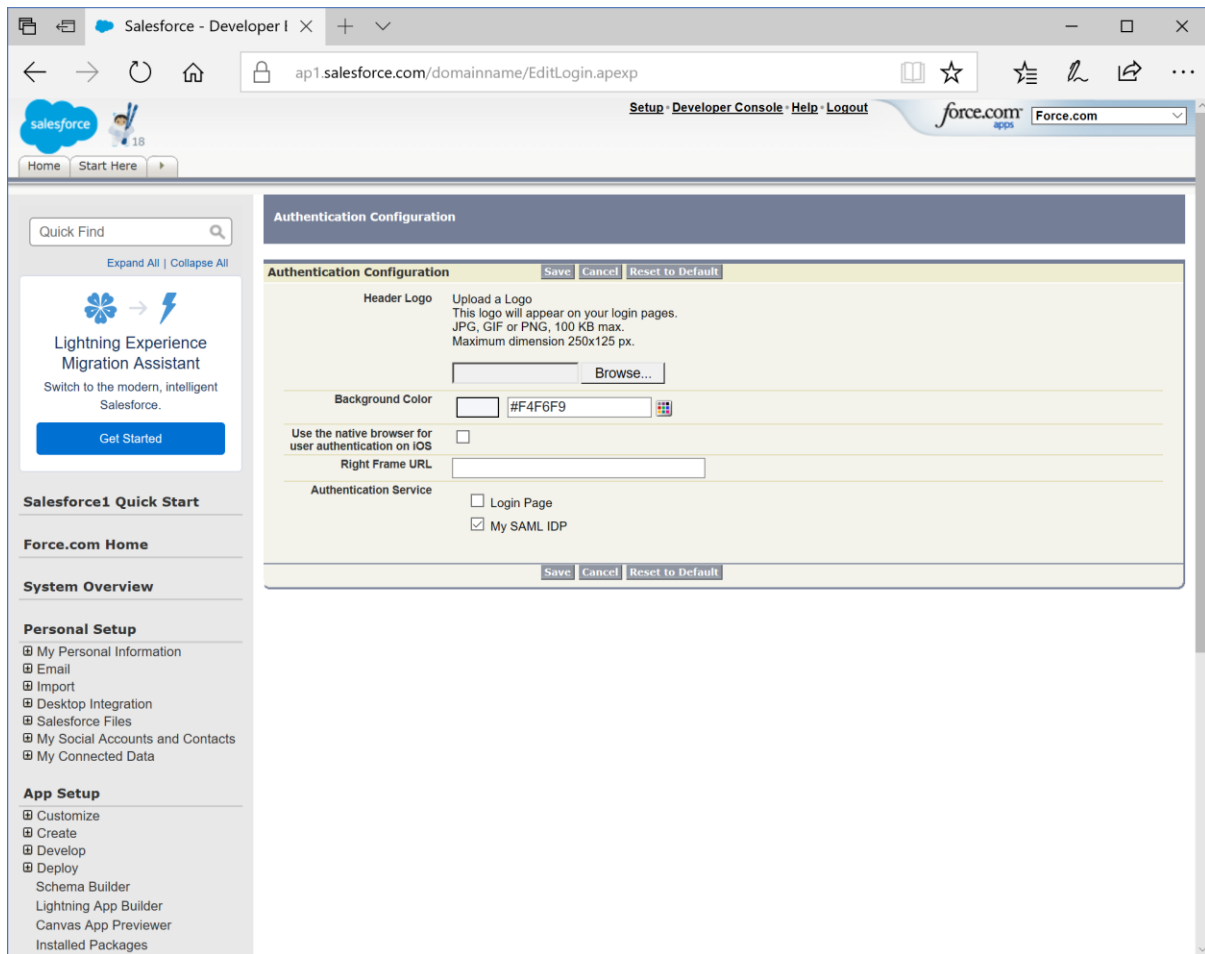

Download the metadata as this is used to configure the identity provider.

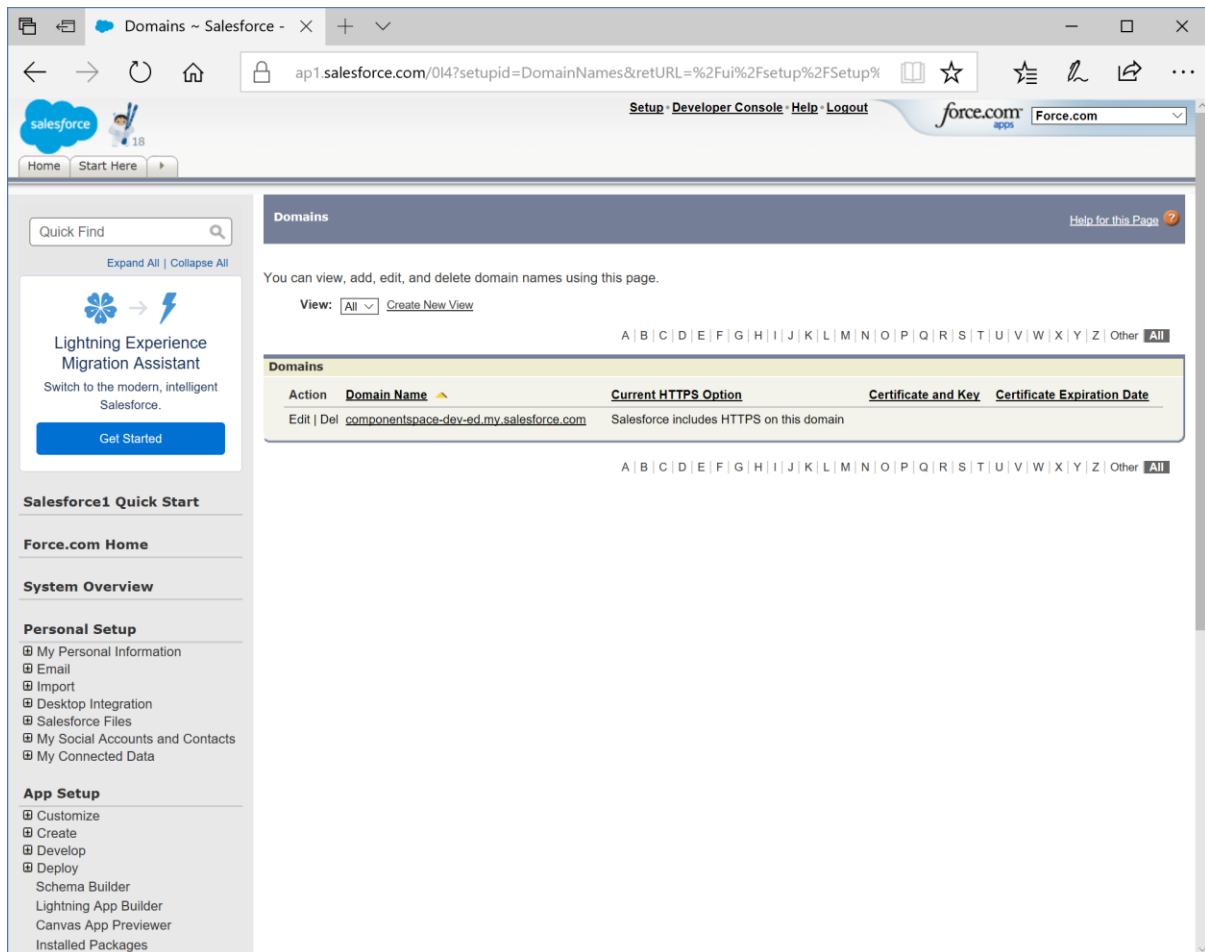
For SP-initiated SSO, select Setup > Domain Management > My Domain.

Ensure the Authentication Service is set to My SAML IDP.

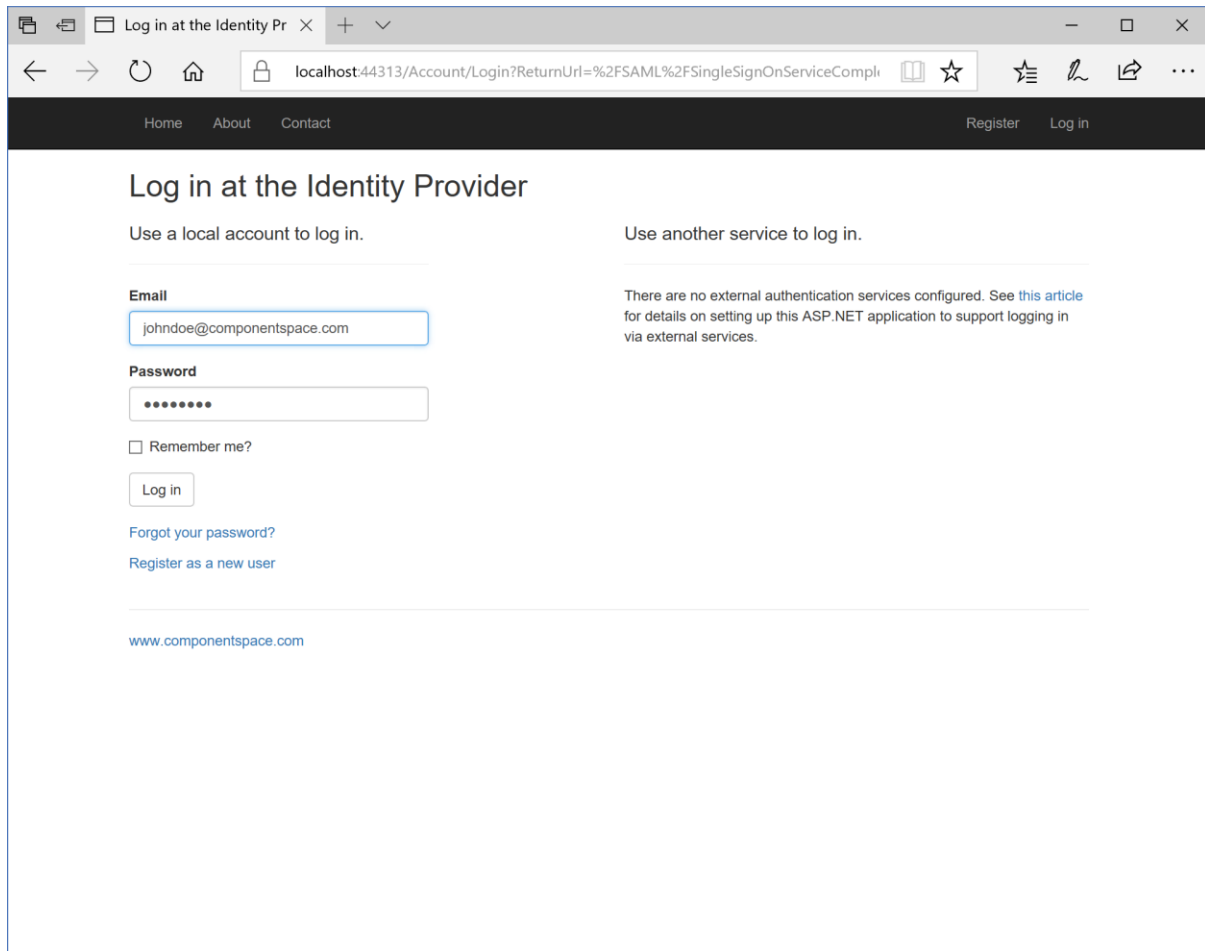
SP-Initiated SSO

Browse to domain URL.

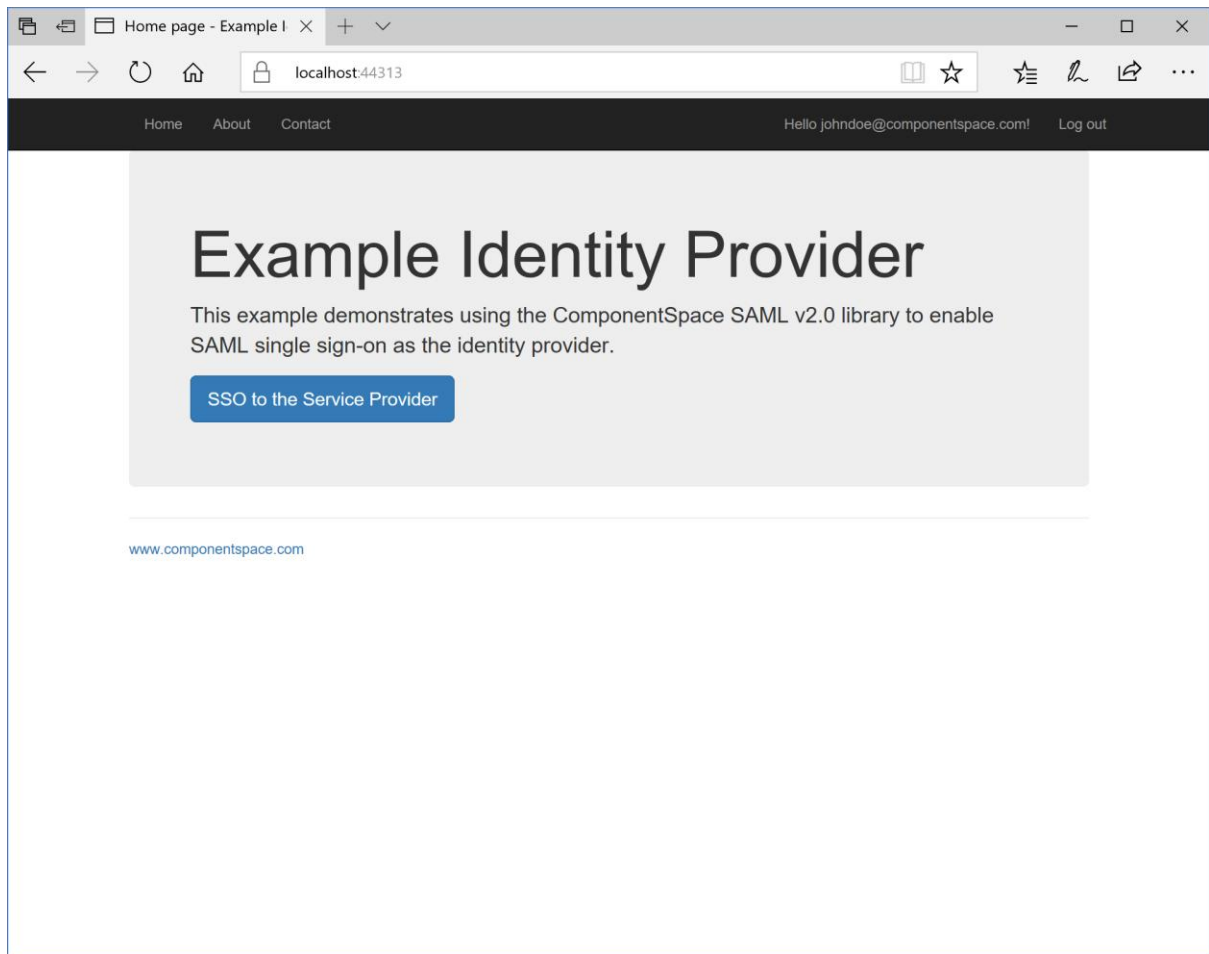
